Making a RA7ALL – a Representation Agreement with all four authorities from section 7 of the BC Representation Agreement Act

The BC Representation Agreement Act (RA Act) is world renowned!

Do NOT send any RA paperwork to Nidus by regular mail or email – it will be shredded or deleted. Click links on next page for more information and tips on making, registering and using RA7ALL.

The age of adulthood in BC is 19 years. Parental rights end when a child turns 19. No one has automatic authority to act on behalf of an adult (not parents or even a spouse). Adults can:


- 1) Be pro-active and make a legal document to give authority to someone; OR,
- Do nothing, and authority will be IMPOSED.

Traditionally, the capability requirements for legal planning documents left out adults who have cognitive difficulties (maybe from a disability at birth, advanced dementia, brain injury, stroke, etc.). These adults could not be pro-active.

Thanks to a grass-roots law reform, BC has a new definition of capability in law.

- We call this the RA7 approach.
- Adults may make a Representation Agreement with authorities from section 7 of the RA Act, even if they have cognitive difficulties. Even if a doctor says the adult is incapable.
- The RA7 is law in BC and accommodates people with cognitive or intellectual impairment/disability.

RECOMMENDATION: Save this document and the Basic RA7ALL form to your device. To avoid compatibility problems, open the PDF files using the universal software program called Adobe Reader.

TIP: You will need a printer and you need to be able to access information online. Get help if you are not familiar with technology. You complete the RA form in hardcopy, so signatures are originals.

Do you have the right package?

Following is a list of the **four** authorities from section 7 of the RA Act (RA7ALL) as in the graphic on page 1.

- 1. Minor and major Health care matters,
- 2. **Personal care** matters,
- 3. Obtain Legal services and instruct counsel...., and
- 4. Routine management of Financial affairs.

RA7 is sometimes used as a generic term. Nidus uses more specific terms (and has different RA7 forms).

- RA7ALL has all 4 authorities (as outlined above);
- RA7H+P has two authorities (minor and major health care matters and personal care matters);
- RA7F+L has two authorities (legal matters and routine management of financial affairs).

The <u>Basic RA7ALL</u> is for naming 1 representative, 1 alternate representative (optional) and a monitor.

TIP: Making a new RA does not automatically cancel a previous one. See link below about Revoking.

The Basic RA7ALL is 13 pages. Download/Save it to your device and open with Adobe Reader then:

- Type in the fillable fields and print a hardcopy, then complete it with dates and signatures.

 OR
- Print a hardcopy and handwrite neatly in fields, then complete it with dates and signatures.

Make a digital copy of the completed RA7ALL for your records – this involves getting it scanned in PDF format (all pages in one file). Then you can upload the scan to the Nidus Registry.

A medical assessment is NOT required for making any type of RA. A legal professional is NOT required.
